TYPICAL PEER PRESCHOOL PROGRAM
Guidelines

The Typical Peer Program allows special education preschool students to interact with children who do not have disabilities. This program implements state and federal guidelines for Early Childhood Special Education. Prior to being admitted to the program, Typical Peers are evaluated to ensure they have good speech, language and behavioral skills and will provide good peer role models for the children with delays. As a Typical Peer, your child will benefit by having a licensed teacher and exposure to a comprehensive early childhood curriculum.

For the benefit of both typical peer and special needs children, the following guidelines have been developed:

1. Preschoolers who are not kindergarten eligible (5 years old by August 1, 2018) may participate in the preschool screenings.
2. It is expected that children will be 4 years old on or before August 1, 2018.
3. Typical Peers must be completely toilet trained and independent in their toileting skills.
4. All Typical Peers will be admitted on a **probationary basis**; they may be dismissed from the Typical Peer program if their behavior is not conducive to the preschool environment. **Dismissal will be at the discretion of the classroom teacher.** If your child needs to be dismissed, you will receive a **pro-rated** refund of the fee cost.
5. Parents are expected to return all paperwork in a timely fashion. Each student will be charged \$100 (\$50 a semester) for classroom supplies. Each family will also be expected to help provide monthly classroom snacks. **If the supply fee is not paid on time, your child will be dismissed from the preschool.**
6. Parents of Typical Peers will receive an end of year progress report.
7. **Transportation is not provided.**
8. We do not give tax identification number due to the fact we are a school corporation.
